

July 20, 2017

The Monett City Council met in regular session, Thursday, July 20, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. in the Monett City Hall Council room at 217 – 5th Street, Monett, Missouri. Attendance was as follows: Mike Brownsberger-Mayor, Jerry Dierker-Commissioner, Al Dohmen-Commissioner, Dennis Pyle-City Administrator, Lisa Crawford-Deputy City Clerk, Russ Balmas-Public Works Superintendent, Georges Daoud-Police Chief, Skip Schaller-Utilities General Manager, Steve Roden-Water Foreman, Murray Bishoff-Monett Times, Kevin Sprengle-Anderson Engineering and Jeff Meredith-Monett Chamber of Commerce.

Mayor Brownsberger called the meeting to order, and the minutes of the previous meeting dated June 20, 2017 were approved as written with a motion from Commissioner Dohmen and a second from Commissioner Dierker. The following vote was taken: Brownsberger-yes, Dierker-yes, Dohmen-yes.

Monthly expenditures, in the amount of \$1,667,640.94 for the month of July, was presented for approval. Motion to approve payment was made by Commissioner Dierker and a second by Commissioner Dohmen. The following vote was taken: Brownsberger-yes, Dierker-yes, Dohmen-yes.

SECOND READING: BILL 8526 (amended), AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, SCHEDULE VII OF THE MONETT CITY CODE RELATED TO RESTRICTED PARKING.

Bill 8526 (amended) was presented for a second reading for an ordinance amending Title III, Schedule VI of the Monett City Code related to restricted parking. The floor was opened to discussion. Murray Bishoff asked if there had been any comments from the public. Commissioner Dohmen said there had been a few and that all were good. With no further discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Dierker to approve the bill, and a second by Commissioner Dohmen. The following vote was taken: Brownsberger-yes, Dierker-yes, Dohmen-yes. Motion having been made and seconded, the bill was duly adopted and became an ordinance of the City. Said bill was signed by the Mayor and attested to by the Deputy City Clerk.


FIRST READING: BILL 8539, AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE MODIFICATION OF A NOTE AND DEED OF TRUST BETWEEN PALABRAS DE VIDA ETERNA FREEWILL BAPTIST CHURCH AND THE CITY OF MONETT.

This is the second modification to the note and deed of trust with the same monthly payment of \$951.08 being made with a \$10,000 sum due on March 1, 2018 instead of \$20,000. Thereafter, monthly payments will be made at \$1,000 on the first day of every month until January 1, 2019, at which time, the entire balance will have been paid.

EMPLOYMENT RECOGNITION: Steve Roden-Water Foreman, was recognized for his 33 years of service to the City of Monett. Steve began his career with the City in June of 1984 as a Meter Reader and was promoted to Water Foreman in August of 1994, where he has remained until present day. His retirement will be effective August 18, 2017.

Department Heads in attendance gave monthly reports.
