Mayor Brownsberger called the meeting to order.


REVIEW BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF ENTERPRISE DRIVE

City Council reviewed the submitted bids from Jeff Asbell Excavating & Trucking, Vaughn Dirtworks and Woody's Express Trucking. Mayor Brownsberger asked Kevin Sprenkle with Anderson Engineering if he had any comments about the bids, to which he stated that he didn't, but thought they were all good bids. City Council agreed to award the contract to Jeff Asbell Excavating & Trucking for \$909,832.10 with Alternate #2 for an additional \$537.25. Commissioner Dierker made a motion to accept the bid with a second from Commissioner Dohmen. The following vote was taken: Brownsberger-yes, Dierker-yes, Dohmen-yes.

Discussion was held on the traffic engineering study from TranSystems relating to the Central Avenue corridor.

Discussion was held on the preliminary specifications for the Public Works building.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned with a motion from Commissioner Dohmen and a second from Commissioner Dierker. The following vote was taken: Brownsberger-yes, Dierker-yes, Dohmen-yes.
